Crisis of Leadership

Key texts: *Isaiah 6*

Principle Themes to Explore

1. With the lack of leaders and the death of Uzziah, Isaiah is granted a vision of God in His temple.
2. In any time of crisis a vision of God permits us to see beyond the dark.
3. Having a vision of God places us in the right condition to hear the call, responsibility and mission.

Suggestions for Teaching

Reflect on the great truth that it is vision and the presence of the Lord that gives us strength, responsibility and mission.

Possible questions for sharing and discussion

1. Read (twice) Isaiah 6:1-7. Ask each one present what they find that is new to them in this text?
2. How can we today have a vision of the glory of God similar to Isaiah's?
3. What primary message about God should every believer offer his or her church?
4. Read Isaiah 6:8-10. What responsibilities do we have towards our neighbours, whoever they may be?
