Title: **Children of the Promise**

Pastoral Group Objectives

Welcome and greet each other. Dedicate some minutes to thanksgiving and pray for the needs of the brethren.

Let's Share the Word

Key Texts: **Genesis 12:1-2 & 15:1-4; 1 Peter 2:9; Rev. 22:1-5; Isaiah 25:8; Matthew 28:20; 1 Corinthians 2:9.**

Themes to Explore

1. God has a plan, it has been revealed and is promised; all our hope is in it. It is an alternative to our plans.
2. In Abram all families are blessed! Some themes to explore: no to human sacrifices; monogamous family; faith in one God; a mission of Israel; one nation of all priests; the same law for all.
3. God has also promised, in the work of the Messiah, salvation, redemption, eternal life, help in everyday life.

Suggestions for Teaching and Spiritual Objectives:

Consider the blessings, values, principles and the promises that God offered Abram, plus the revelation of Himself.

Possible Questions for Deeper Study, Sharing and Application:

1. What thoughts about God, His covenant, love and providence does the study of this week's lesson offer us?
 2. In what ways, thanks to the progeny of Abram, are all the families of the earth blessed? List them.
 3. What important and new teachings, in relation to the plans of God for everyone, has this lesson offered you?
 4. What blessings that we receive from God's covenant with Abram are valid and necessary for our time?

Renew your commitment and efforts to witness about your hope. Ask God to put you into contact with those who need faith and answers.
