## **Pastoral Group Objectives**

Plan to contact and visit all the members of the group this quarter, firstly the elderly, those who are alone, suffering or who have lost a loved one. This is especially important at this time when many feel isolated.

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## **Let's Share the Word**

**Key Texts: 1 Corinthians 10: 1-11; (all texts indicated in Numbers 11: 1-1)**

## **Themes to Explore**

1. The lesson presents some facts of rebellion in the history of Israel in the desert: they were the cause of anxiety and stress.
2. Discomfort, stress, impatience, suspicion of leaders lead to distrust, criticism, distrust, and finally rebellion.
3. The great challenge is to build and maintain faith in God. He is above everything and everyone. Moses is a model.

## **Suggestions for Teaching and Spiritual Objectives:**

Draw lessons from the history of Israel and reflect on how we can grow in trust in God and effectively testify to him.

## **Possible Questions for Deeper Study, Sharing and Application:**

1. If you could define the characteristics of those rebellions with a thought, what words would you use? List them
  2. Why did some of the people not keep faith in God and his leaders despite God's great acts?
  3. What lesson for us comes from the action of Moses in this difficult moment in the history of Israel?
  4. What life lessons and what models should we assume in ourselves so as to be effective witnesses?
