Let's Share the Word

Key Texts: ***Job 19:25-27; 1 Timothy 6:16; Psalms 49 & 71; Isaiah 26:14, 19; Daniel 12***

Themes to Explore

- The hope that has engaged people the most is the one that opens up a future of life overcoming death.
 - Only the Scriptures emphasise the resurrection event. This hope is also announced in the Old Testament.
 - This hope is founded in the power of God; He is the giver of life and the agent of resurrection. ALWAYS!
 - All the genuine believers of ancient times were drawn to and trusted deeply in God, in Yahweh.

Pastoral Group Objectives

1. Focus on the promises related to the Resurrection already present in the Old Testament.
2. Underline the promises received by the Lord's servants in ancient times, identify those closest to us.

4. How can we testify of our faith in the resurrection to those who are in contact with us?
