

# Lesson 6: Prayer Warriors

## A. Lessons about prayer from Daniel

1. What are some well-known stories about Daniel recorded in the Bible?
2. If you read the Book of Daniel, you'll discover that Daniel was a prayer warrior. How did Daniel respond to the decree of King Nebuchadnezzar to kill all the wise men of Babylon? Daniel 2:17-23
3. What can we learn about the prayer life of Daniel from his response to the trap that was set for him during the reign of Darius the Mede? Daniel 6:4-10
4. Daniel knelt when he prayed. Daniel 6:10 Should we follow his example? Luke 22:41, Acts 7:60, 9:40, 20:36, Psalm 95:6, etc.
5. Are other postures in prayer acceptable to God? (2 Chronicles 20:5-6, Luke 18:11,13, Revelation 4:9-11, Deuteronomy 9:25, 1 Thessalonians 5:17, etc.

## B. Lessons about prayer from Enoch

1. Jude 14-15 Enoch was a prophet of God.
2. Genesis 5:22-24 What lessons can we learn from this brief inspired testimony about the life of Enoch?
3. Adam was still alive when Enoch was born. What might Enoch have learned about prayer and a relationship with God from his forefather Adam?

## C. Lessons about prayer from Moses

1. Exodus 33:7-11,12-23 What lessons can we learn about prayer from this conversation between the LORD and Moses?
2. What lesson can we learn from the prayer of Moses for his sister Miriam? Numbers 12:13 (see also Matthew 5:44)
3. What lesson can we learn from the prayer of Moses after his people worshipped the golden calf at Mount Sinai? Exodus 32:31-32
4. What can we learn about prayer from other prayers of Moses? Exodus 15:24-25, 17:4, Deuteronomy 9:22-29, etc.

## D. Lessons about prayer from Hannah

1. 1 Samuel 1:9-15 What are your thoughts about the intensity of Hannah's prayer?
2. What can we learn from Hannah's prayer recorded in 1 Samuel 2:1-10? (see also Ephesians 6:18)
3. 1 Samuel 2:19 What do you think Hannah was doing while she was weaving a robe each year for her son?
4. What is the connection between the prayers of Hannah for her son and his life of faithful service as a prophet of the LORD? 1 Samuel 1:27-28.
